Introductory remarks were that in future meetings we will be "spruced up" featuring more power point presentations; an idea inspired by club member Ashley Meade who suggested more in-depth discussions of the "Show and tell" mineral of the month so as to learn more about them. Some ideas brought up for field trips for next year were Benson Mines, Bush Farm (with new backhoe work done), Canadian Museum of Nature, Ottawa.
