Minutes from the November Meeting:

The meeting was called to order at 6:20 PM. Five members attended the meeting. Joanna read the minutes from the October meeting. Barb Decker made a motion to accept the minutes; Robert Lake 2nd the motion. All in favor. Joanna gave the Treasurer's report. The Canton library has been paid for 2019 for meeting space. There are no meetings in Jan. and Feb. Bill and Joanna organized and inventoried the signs and bases in the storage shed. There are 45 signs and as many or more bases. They are all sealed in a large tote. We talked some about next year's showrelated expenses and what we might do in terms of fund raising during the year in order to have more funds on hand prior to the show. Robert Lake suggested a membership drive, college involvement and specimen raffles at each meeting.

It was suggested that \$1.00 would be way too low and that some shows charge \$3.00 -\$6.00. We will talk more about this in the future. Bill mentioned that \$2.00 admission fee shouldn't be a cost factor in terms of cutting back attendance.
